"To know wisdom and instruction, to understand words of insight..." (1:2)

- "To know..." (Hebrew yada)
- "...wisdom..." (Heb. *hokma*)
- "...and instruction..." (Heb. *musar*)
- "...to understand..." (Heb. bin)
- "...words of insight." (Heb. *bina*)

"to receive instruction in wise dealing, in righteousness, justice, and equity;" (1:3)

- "...to receive instruction..." (Heb. *musar*)
- "...in wise dealing..." (Heb. haskel)
- "...in righteousness, justice and equity..." (Heb. sedeq, mishpat, mesharim)

"to give prudence to the simple, knowledge, and discretion to the youth." (1:4)

- "...to give prudence..." (Heb. 'orma)
- "...to the simple..." (Heb. *peti*)
- "...knowledge and discretion..." (Heb. da'at, mezimma)
- "...to the youth..." (Heb. *na'ar*)

"Let the wise hear and increase in learning, and the one who understands obtain guidance," (1:5)

- "...and the one who understands..." (Heb. nabon)

- "...and a saying..." (Heb. melisa)
