PSALM 19

GETTING STARTED

• Where is your favorite place to go outside? Is there somewhere where you feel God's presence outside?

SCRIPTURE STUDY

Before you begin: Open with prayer and spend a minute or two in silence before God. Have multiple people ask the Holy Spirit to enter your time together and illuminate your hearts and minds to scripture.

- Have someone read the passage in its entirety aloud. As a group, summarize the passage, and as you do so, note any observations, questions, and exciting insights you found while reading through the text. What jumped out at you? What was something you noticed now that you didn't see before?
- What does it mean for the heavens and skies to declare God's glory? How does the sky communicate about God's care in the world?
- How does this Psalm comment on God's word to his people?
- What is the fear of the LORD? How do we cultivate a healthy fear of God in our lives?

WRAPPING UP

 The Psalm ends with a plea to take away sins, and for the meditation of our hearts and the words we speak to be acceptable in God's sight. Take some time to think about your sin. Confess it if you must. What might it look like for you to live a life that enables your words and your heart to be acceptable in God's sight?
