LUKE 19:28-44

## **SCRIPTURE STUDY**

**Before you begin:** Open with prayer and spend a minute or two in silence before God. Have multiple people ask the Holy Spirit to enter your time together and illuminate your hearts and minds to scripture.

- Have someone read the passages in their entirety aloud. As a group, summarize the passage, and as you do so, note any observations, questions, and exciting insights you found while reading through the text.
   What jumped out at you? What was something you noticed now that you didn't see before?
- What is significant about Jesus riding into Jerusalem on a colt or foal?
  Matthew is specific about it being a donkey, yet Mark and Luke say otherwise. Why the differences?
- Jesus's response to the Pharisees is quite shocking. What does he mean by the stones would cry out if his disciples were quiet? (The OT reference is Hab 2:11)
- How come Jesus weeps over Jerusalem?
- As you think about Jesus going to the cross, what moves within you as we approach Easter? Do you feel sorrow for your sin? How might you surrender to king Jesus?
