GETTING STARTED

• Is it possible to be amazed and fearful at the same time? Tell a story about a time when you were both amazed and fearful.

SCRIPTURE STUDY

Before you begin: Open with prayer and spend a minute or two in silence before God. Have multiple people ask the Holy Spirit to enter into your time together and illuminate your hearts and minds to scripture.

- Have someone read the passage aloud and note any observations, questions, and exciting insights you found while reading through the text to share with the group. What jumped out at you? What was something you noticed now that you didn't see before?
- Why do you think Jesus disclosed to his disciples the information he did surrounding his death and resurrection?
- What do you think led James and John to make such a request in verse 37? How did Jesus reply? What did he mean by "you don't know what you're asking?"
- What does Jesus mean in verse 43 when he says, "whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant?" How does Jesus come to serve us?

WRAPPING UP

• What have you discovered in this passage that challenges you to live in a way that follows Jesus' lead?
