

THE TRUTH ABOUT KING JESUS

JOHN 18:28-38

SCRIPTURE STUDY

Before you begin: Open with prayer and spend a minute or two in silence before God. Have multiple people ask the Holy Spirit to enter your time together and illuminate your hearts and minds to scripture.

- How do you like to spend Easter? are there any special traditions you and your family hold to celebrate this special day?
- Have someone read the passages in their entirety aloud. As a group, summarize the passage, and as you do so, note any observations, questions, and exciting insights you found while reading through the text. What jumped out at you? What was something you noticed now that you didn't see before?
- What is happening in verses 28–32? How come the Jews want to put Jesus to death? How does the statement in verse 31 signal how Jesus's words might be fulfilled in his death?
- What does Jesus mean by saying, "My kingdom is not of this world?" Describe what he means in the context of this passage.
- The irony of Pilate's question, "What is truth" is a question for the reader as he stands before Jesus. How does our world think about truth today? How does the truth about Jesus, his death, resurrection, and ascension change our lives?
