- 3. How come Jesus had to be conceived by the Holy Spirit, and born of a virgin?
- 4. How do we make sense of the phrase, "Nothing is impossible with God?" Does that mean we can do anything we want? How would this apply to someone struggling with a terminal illness when the end is inevitable? Or an area in your life where you feel un-equipped?
- 5. How does Mary serve as an example of the faith for the Church?
