- How can you distinguish between righteous and unrighteous anger?
- Why are we tempted to merely hear the word? Is this saying that works are necessary for salvation? Why or why not?
- Is the Word of God reaching your heart and leading to noticeable change? Share the most recent example.
- What is your response to James' portrayal of true religion and worthless religion in v. 26–27? How does your understanding of spiritual life need to be redefined?
- What does it mean to be "unstained from the world?" What are ways that you are particularly vulnerable to adopting the world's way of thinking?
- What is one way that you need to implement the truths of this passage into your life?
