 - What sticks out to you about these passages?
 - Why is discipline necessary in families? How is this loving or wise for families?
 - Does God discipline us? How does he do that?
- Read Proverbs 13:14, 17:6, 20:29
 - What sticks out to you about these passages?
 - What do these passages say about having grandchildren?
 What role should/shouldn't play in the lives of their children and grandchildren?
- Take some time to pray with your groups about your marriages, your families, or your grandparenting. Use scripture as a way to pray over your struggles and victories as you lift up your requests to God.
