- In the third parable, how is the "lost" son (verses 11-19) similar and different from the coin and sheep from the previous parables?
- What does the Father's response (verses 20–24) teach us about God's heart toward those who repent?
- Why does Jesus spend the remainder of this parable on the older son? What is Jesus teaching?
- Why do you think we struggle with attitudes of selfrighteousness toward others? How do you feel about God's heart of compassion toward repentant sinners? How should this shape our attitude toward others?
