

- Why does Paul circumcise Timothy when the Jerusalem council concluded that circumcision is not necessary for salvation? (see 15:1-21)
- What is Christian freedom for? How might this view of freedom affect our reactions to current circumstances? (1 Cor. 9:19–23; Gal. 5:1–15)
- How can we understand Paul's insistence on justice in v. 37 in light of the previous question?
- Compare and contrast Lydia's reaction to Paul's message with the merchant's reaction.
- How does this chapter inform our attitudes and theology when sharing the gospel with others?
