GETTING STARTED

2 TIMOTHY 4:9-15

Talk briefly about a time when you worked together in a team of people. What
were you looking to accomplish? What were some roadblocks/interpersonal
problems that were hard to overcome?

SCRIPTURE STUDY

Before you begin: Open with prayer and spend a minute or two in silence before God. Have multiple people ask the Holy Spirit to enter your time together and illuminate your hearts and minds to scripture.

- Have someone read the passage in its entirety aloud. As a group, summarize
 the passage, and as you do so, note any observations, questions, and exciting
 insights you found while reading through the text. What jumped out at you?
 What was something you noticed now that you didn't see before?
- What would you say is the mission of the Church? Not just Glenwood but the universal church as a whole?
 - Just because a church doesn't look exactly like ours doesn't mean they aren't doing it right. What are some things we can appreciate about different churches and denominations?
- What do you notice about the people Paul lists in the passage? Where else do you see their ministry in the New Testament? Take some time to discuss the team members and their contributions to the church and its ministry.

• What are some dreams and ideas your LIFEgroup can do this year to further the mission of God's kingdom? What might it look like to do that together?
