GETTING STARTED

How does God's creation speak of his majesty and glory?

SCRIPTURE STUDY

Before you begin: Open with prayer and spend a minute or two in silence before God. Have multiple people ask the Holy Spirit to enter your time together and illuminate your hearts and minds to scripture.

- Have someone read the passage in its entirety aloud. As a group, summarize
 the passage, and as you do so, note any observations, questions, and exciting
 insights you found while reading through the text. What jumped out at you?
 What was something you noticed now that you didn't see before?
- What does the phrase mean "you have set your glory above the heavens?"
- Why does the psalmist describe that God has established a stronghold from the mouth of children and infants? What does this mean?
- What does it mean when it says man was made a little less than God? Describe what the psalmist is referring to when he writes about thisnin verses 4-6.
- How does this psalm speak of the coming messiah?

• What can we learn from David here about praising God in our prayers and how can we import this into our own prayer life?
